Decision 1056.1 – 07-09-2021

Having heard the:

- The Chair of VGST, Arne Lassche

And considering that:

- VGST has had an official warning with a period of improvement of six weeks.
- VGST is organizing their introduction period during the Kick-in and thus VGST is hindering the Student Union in its policy responsibilities and the implementation thereof to introduce students to their living environment.
- This is not allowed according to the Recognition Regulations.

Decision 1059.1 – 28-09-2021

Having heard the:

- SU Board

And considering that:

- The Dutch government decided to lower the tuition fee for 2021/2022 from €2168 to €1.084. The reason being, possible study delay, in the past or the future, could (have) led to more costs for students. For reference, see piece 35836, 3 of the Lower House of the States-General.
- The government decided to generically compensate all students with their tuition fee - over other possible ways to compensate students - because it is almost impossible to determine per individual student how many extra costs they have had or will have due to corona.
- The WAR decided that the financial support per activism grant for full time activities is equal to the average tuition fee period in the recognized period with a part-time grant as a minimum.

The Student Union Board decides that:

- The SU board members will receive for the academic year 2021-2022 €2112,- compensation for their tuition fee.
