

Procedure application activism recognition

The assessment of the application for an activism recognition shall go according to a set procedure. The request shall be assessed by the Activism recognition Committee (AC). The assessment happens according to the following criteria:

1. The report meets the guidelines.
2. The student has succeeded in explaining his/her learning experience in a clear manner in the report and in the meeting.
3. The student convinces both committees of his/her learning experience.

The procedure

In the first step of the procedure your report will be presented to the AC, from which two members will read the report. After reading and judging your report, there are three options for which step is taken next:

- You will be invited to a short meeting in which the AC will ask further questions about your report. This meeting will take approximately 30 minutes. After the meeting, the recognition is awarded.
- The written reflection shows sufficient reflection, based on which the AC does not deem it necessary to invite you for the meeting. Your recognition will be awarded directly.
- If the AC decides that both the written report and the meeting show an inadequate amount of reflection, there will be a final meeting with a staff member who is experienced in the field of reflections. This will first be discussed with you, before it is set in action.



Edubadge

After the activism recognition is granted to you, you will also receive an Edubadge, which you can request online. The application procedure for the badge is simple and will be given to you after you are awarded the recognition. The Edubadge is an exclusive digital badge with which you can show that you did a full-time board year and that you were recognized for this by the University of Twente. The badge is easily shared through social media, such as LinkedIn. This makes the badge the ideal way to show your network and your potential employers that you have been active for the University of Twente!



Certificate distribution

When your report has been approved, the certificate will be printed and signed by the Student Union and the Rector Magnificus. Therefore, it will take several weeks after the approval, before you can collect the certificate. As soon as your certificate is ready, the AC will contact you to make an appointment with you to collect your recognition certificate.
